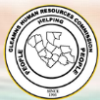
Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) Program

The goal of the CSBG program is to reduce and/or prevent poverty through community-based educational activities, which lead to a greater degree of self-sufficiency on the part of low-income persons. The federal grant program permits a wide range of activities to assist participants with education, housing, emergency services, community involvement, referral, and income management.

Our CSBG Programs include:

- **General Emergency Assistance Program (GEAP)**

GEAP provides emergency rental assistance and mortgage assistance to income-eligible individuals. Individuals are required to provide proof of an emergency that occurred within thirty (30) days of application.

- **Case Management**

Case Management is designed to provide educational and transportation assistance to socio-economically challenged adults in becoming self-sufficient and improving their quality of life. This program provides a support mechanism that helps individuals to obtain education beyond high school or prepare individuals to become marketable in the work place. Assistance may be available according to needs, as in tuition, uniforms, books, classroom supplies, and driver's license training.

- **Youth Leadership Program—
Greenwood County Only**

YLP is designed to provide educational opportunities to income-eligible students with the purpose of encouraging life and leadership skills. Students must attend schools in Greenwood County and be between the ages of 12-18. Enrollment may be open throughout the year.

Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)

LIHEAP is a federally-funded program designed to help eligible low-income households with their utility bills. Funds can be used to pay light bills or provide assistance with fuel and even air conditioners. Whether you have a crisis with your utilities or just need help with paying a current light bill, assistance may be available.

If you are interested in assistance:

Eligibility and benefits for all programs are mainly determined by **gross** household income, number of household members, and the need or emergency of the situation. Documents needed at the time of intake include:

- Current Driver's License (or state-issued ID) of applicant.
- Social security cards for all persons living in your household.
- Proof of gross household income for the past 30 days.
- Proof of need/emergency (such as utility bill or eviction notice).

Additional information may be needed. Please contact your local CSBG/LIHEAP office or the Program Director at the Greenwood location. (Contact info. is listed on the back of this brochure.)
